

## FISHING TUITION DETAILS

We start by looking at your sounder settings and transducer placement and fine tune so you can see the fish.

We then go out to several types of reefs - natural ledges, man-made drops, a ship wreck and tyre reef and see what the different bottom structures look like and how the fish living and feeding around them show up on your tuned in sounder.

We then move into accurate anchoring where I will show you how and where to place the anchor so that the boat will always be over the fish or structure you now recognize, this is when you can try your luck for a fish.

We then discuss the best burley to use and burlying techniques, when to burly / how much etc.

We will discuss best rigs and times of the day and year to catch the different species and answer any questions about fishing or boating you may have.

You can bring a friend and you're free to copy the GPS points for the reefs we visit.

Rate - \$75 per hour, 4 hours are required to visit all the spots having a quick fish or 2 hour version (no fishing) if required.

All required safety equipment

## Bait

- Two x 2kgs blocks of pilchards
- one x 1kgs squid heads
- one x 1kgs cockles

## Enough FUEL to travel up to 50kms
